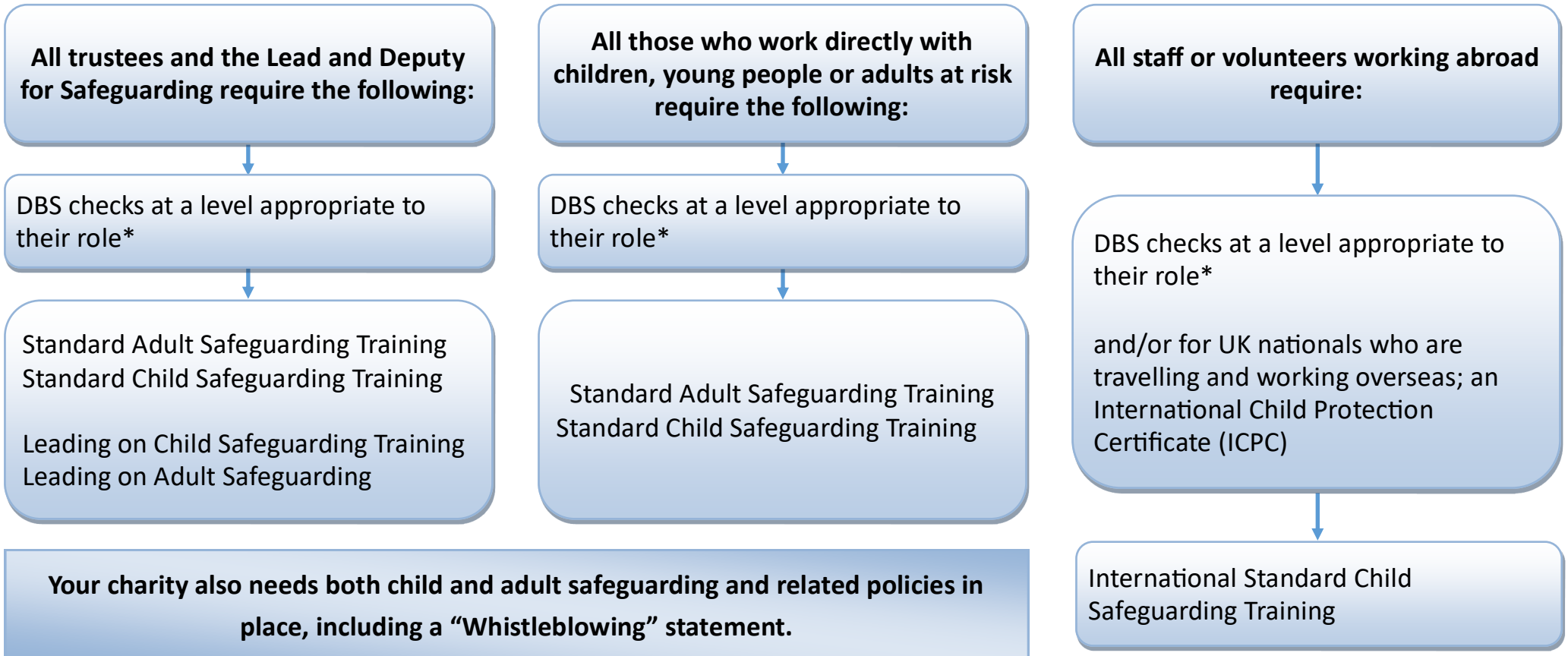


Charities and Safeguarding: England and Wales



Below is a basic overview of the services SAFEcic provide that can help you meet your legal responsibilities if your charity works directly with children, young people or adults at risk. This flowchart should not be taken as legal advice and is designed to be used as a brief overview only.



*Most roles that involve working with children, vulnerable adults or adults at risk are eligible for at least an enhanced DBS check. Trustees who do not have direct contact with vulnerable groups may still be eligible due to the nature of the charity's work. For further information contact our DBS team.
